1. **Mayor's Announcements**
2. **Solar Resource Discussion** – We have an opportunity to diversify our power resources to include solar energy. Council will discuss the options related to the level of investment in solar resources the city is willing to undertake.
3. ***Emory Street Sidewalk Replacement Project** – The FY2021 Capital Budget includes \$100,000 to make repairs to the existing sidewalk that runs along the westside of Emory Street/SR 81 from the city-owned greenspace to Soule Street. At the August Work Session, we discussed installing conduit for pedestrian lighting. We have attached a draft copy of the plans with the conduit shown.
4. **Water Main Replacement Project** – The FY2021 Capital Budget includes \$1,360,000 to replace a 40+ year old section of our water system that serves Oxford Road, Keel Street, and Perry Circle. We were not selected for the 2020 Community Development Block Grant funding for this project. We have the option to re-apply for the 2021 award phase.
5. ***Right-of-Way Survey** – Jordan Engineering has completed the city's right-of-way survey as agreed to in the original scope of work. It is proposed that we hire Jordan Engineering to complete an expansion of the city-wide right-of-way in the northwestern quadrant of the city. We discussed this item at the August Work Session. We have attached the proposal. In addition, we have attached the original proposal, the minutes from when it was approved, and a list of the invoices.
6. ***Native Vegetation Ordinance** – Council will discuss the adoption of a native vegetation ordinance. We have attached draft copies of the proposed ordinance and planting list.
7. ***Proposed Amendment to Sec. 8-124. Non-licensed sales** – Staff will present to Council a proposed amendment to the sections of the city's non-licensed sales ordinance pertaining to the farmers market.
8. **Annual Mayor and Council Retreat** – Council will continue their discussion on this year's retreat.
