The parade begins at 10:00 a.m. The parade route is posted on the city website at www.Oxfordgeorgia.org or you can pick up a copy at City Hall. The route will also be posted in the Covington News.

Awards and recognition will be presented by Mayor Jerry Roseberry after the parade at Old Church. Entertainment will be provided by Shane Millwood Band. There will also be concessions, and the Oxford Lions will be providing free watermelon and popcorn.
