The purpose of this hearing is for the first reading of an ordinance to repeal and adopt a revised ordinance respecting: Chapter 41, "Subdivision and Land Development Regulations".

Oliver described the three differences which will be included upon recommendations by City Attorney, David Strickland.

- 1. To add Article VIII. Surety for Completion of Improvements.
- 2. Under Article IV, Section 41-401 (2). Final Plat Stage, the City Council vests this authority to the Planning Commission.
- 3. Streets must be dedicated to City.

Citizen Comments:

LaTrelle Oliver asked "are the streets adequately wide enough within the subdivision requirements?"

Councilman Oliver: all streets must conform to GDOT regulations.

Councilman Windham asked "In what instance will there not be curbing?"

Councilman Oliver: Where there are street jogs.

There being no further questions or discussion, <u>a motion was made by Windham seconded by Oliver to adjourn the meeting at 6:18 pm. The council vote was unanimous.</u>
