Mayor Roseberry – The city tax digest is half of what it was five years ago. In terms of tax revenue, sales tax, insurance, and all taxes collected it is just over six hundred thousand dollars. Our budget from the government side is approximately \$1.2 million. We collect enough taxes to pay about half of the city's operations not counting electric and water.
