New Construction and/or Occupied Housing Rehabilitation Program

The City of Oxford is pre-qualifying licensed general contractors and/or lead renovation firms for the Community HOME Investment Program (CHIP) homeowner rehabilitation program. These programs are funded by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) via the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) and will be subject to all federal program requirements and the local housing policies and procedures.

Interested general contractors must submit a Contractor Application form for consideration. Application forms will be accepted on an on-going basis until completion of the programs; however, only qualified contractors will receive bid packages as they become available.
