- 3. George Holt made a motion to appoint Erik Oliver to serve as Councilmember for the remainder of the Post 1 term. Laura McCanless seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously (6/0). Erik Oliver was sworn in by City Attorney David Strickland and joined the Councilmembers on the dais.

- 7. Appointment of Philip McCanless to the DDA

Mike Ready made a motion to appoint Philip McCanless to the DDA. George Holt seconded the motion. The motion carried (6/0). Laura McCanless abstained.

8. Authorization to sign the Local Option Sales Tax (LOST) Agreement with Newton County (Attachment C)

Jim Windham made a motion to authorize signing the LOST Agreement with Newton County. Jeff Wearing seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously (7/0). (Attachment D)

12. Consider Proposal from Nelsnick Enterprises for a Water and Wastewater System Development Charge Study (Attachment H)

Bill Andrew stated that he had asked ECG several months ago if a rate study could be conducted, and Oxford was put in the queue. They are now ready to work on the study, so Nelsnick has agreed to conduct a study on tap fees only for \$3,000.

Jim Windham made a motion to approve the proposal from Nelsnick Enterprises. Laura McCanless seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously (7/0).

13. Task Order Estimate from Viper Security for Completing Camera System at Asbury Street Park (Appendix I)

George Holt made a motion to approve the task order estimate from Viper Security. Mike Ready seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously (7/0).

14. Authorize the Mayor to Accept a Proposal for Services from the Carl Vinson Institute of Government for a Classification and Compensation Study for the City (Appendix J)
