

## Improve your TREE-Literacy

- The City of Oxford has over 1,750 public trees growing along street rights-of-way, in parks, and around public facilities.
- The value of these trees is over \$6.47 million dollars!!! That's approximately \$3,785 per tree!
- There are 86 different species among the public tree population.
- The most common species found are:

Species Common Name	Number of Trees	Percent of Total
Dogwood, Flowering	243	14%
Oak, Water	228	13%
Crapemyrtle	137	8%
Oak, Willow	117	7%
Pine, Loblolly	99	6%

- There are 4 different pines found in Oxford: slash pine, shortleaf pine, loblolly pine, and white pine.
- There are 13 different oak trees found in Oxford: cherrybark, chestnut, laurel, live, Nuttall, Oglethorpe, post, sawtooth, scarlet, Shumard, Southern red, water, white, and willow.
